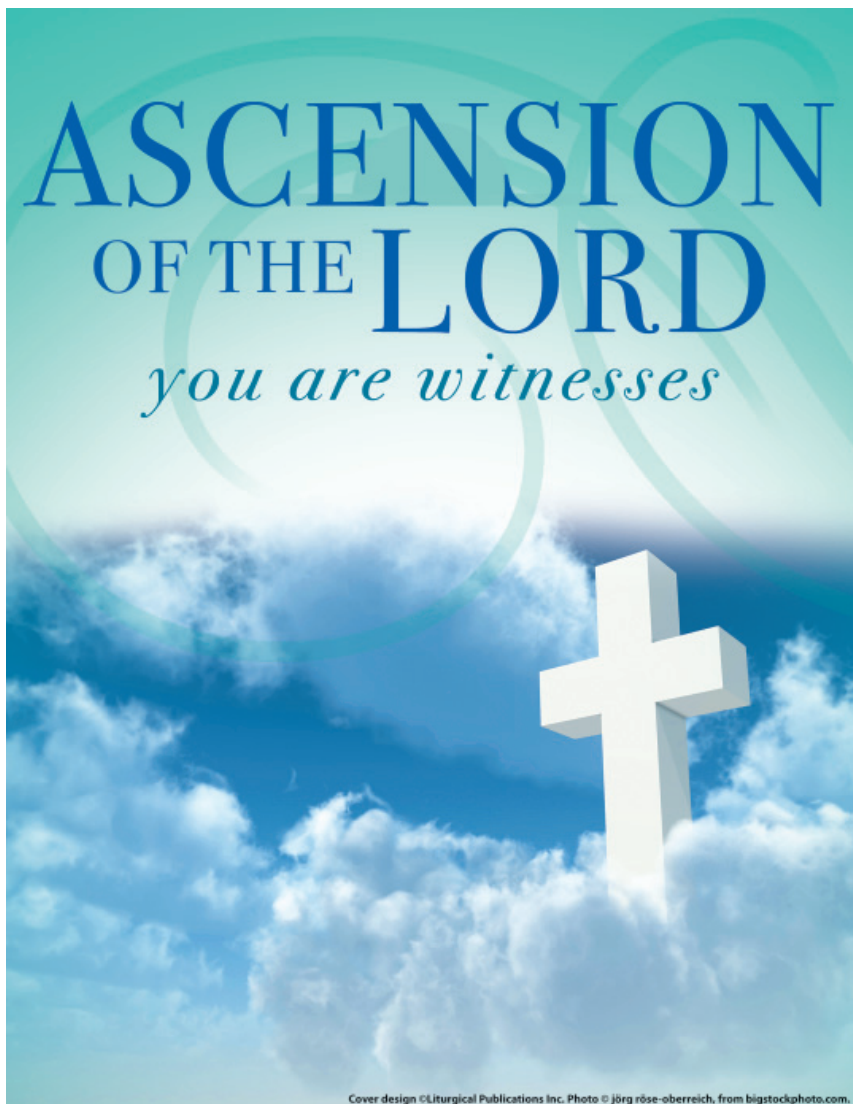

To the Confirmation candidates:



Be Sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit

Today we pray with our 158 Confirmation candidates who will be confirmed on Tuesday, May 18, at the Basilica. On that day, they will receive a full outpouring of the Holy Spirit that will increase and deepen the grace they received in Baptism. Through Baptism we become God's children, sharers in Christ and His priestly, prophetic, and royal ministry, and temples of the Holy Spirit.
