
A Message from Father Tim

9th Grade Confirmation Update

Our Faith Formation staff has been busy making plans for our upcoming year and we are excited to announce that this year we will be offering a slightly different curriculum for the Year One (9th Grade) sessions. As in the past, our first semester will be spent teaching the students about the mission and message of Jesus in a small group setting in the homes of the catechists. Students will also participate in a group service experience, and participate in a day-long retreat during the first semester.

Our second semester will offer students two options. We hope that by offering two options for our students, we will better meet the needs of all our students and families. Parents and students are encouraged to begin discussing which one of the options they would like to participate in; and at our September parent meeting, we will be asking students to register for the option of their choice.

Option One encompasses the auditions, a workshop, rehearsals, and preparation for *Passion Play*, culminating in the presentation of the play to our parish community on March 19 at 8:00 p.m. In **Option Two** teens will get the opportunity to get to know Christ better through the T3 Bible Timeline for teens in 2010. Engaging and humorous videos featuring Mark Hart lead into relevant small-group discussions seeking to understand the depth and importance of scripture to the Catholic faith. Food, drinks and a "tricked-out" Emmaus Room all make this Bible study a comfortable and welcoming experience. Deacon Sam Catapano and Chris Kostelc will co-lead this exploration into the holy Word of God.

We look forward to seeing all of you at our September 20 parent/student meeting. During the meeting we will share more details of our two options for the second semester as well as share small group information. Faith Formation Registration Fees

As a reminder, please take note of the fees for the different levels of Faith Formation listed below:

Per student for Pre-K through Kindergarten
- \$50 for parishioners or \$70 for non-parishioners

Per student for First through Eighth Grade
- \$75 for parishioners or \$100 for non-parishioners

Per student for Ninth through Tenth Grade
- \$100 for parishioners or \$150 for non-parishioners
(additional fee for retreat registrations)

\$250 Family Maximum for those registering before August 15, 2009

Elementary and Middle School student Home School Fee is \$35 per student.

A late fee of \$20 per student will be applied to all registrations received at the Parish Office after August 15, 2009. (New parishioners are exempt).

JustFaith An Invitation

Our Catholic faith and Biblical tradition extend an extraordinary invitation to each of us to become agents of God's compassion and healing in a wounded world. The Good News of Christ is both a comfort and a promise for the poor and, at the same time, a call to those of us who are not poor to be linked with God's vision of justice and reconciliation.

JustFaith, a 30-week adult formation program, offers an opportunity for us to experience this spiritual journey into compassion. Most of us long to be a generous and compassionate people; however, the occasions to explore this tradition in a deliberate and engaging way have largely not been available.

JustFaith is a formation process and spiritual journey. Over the course of seven to eight months, participants meet weekly for readings, videos, lecture, discussion, prayer, retreats, and hands-on experiences in justice education. The intent is to provide a tapestry of learning opportunities that emphasize and enliven the remarkable justice tradition of the Church. It will be a life changing experience!

The Great Adventure is a Catholic Bible Study with its cornerstone being the Bible Timeline.

Jeff Cavins has identified 14 "narrative" books of the Bible that tell the story from beginning to end allowing a chronological story to emerge. Store To Door helps me because I cannot lift and carry heavy groceries because of arthritis, etc. in my back.

I am very happy with your service. I have to use a power chair when going out so your service is a lifesaver.

Thank you for your help. I have severe spinal, lower back and knee problems. I don't know what I would do without Store To Door. Thank you and God bless you.

I have an artificial leg to put on. We hear the phone ring but have not been able to answer it in time. Since we are never gone, please keep ringing until we answer. My husband's leg problems are severe. He needs lots of time, too, to get to the phone. Your service was a God send because months ago when my husband could no longer drive, we were really, truly desperate. We have no friends or family. We are only children at 74 and 75 years of age with health problems. A comment: All our lives we have been very active adults. We were dependent on no one. Five years ago, my husband had a quadruple bypass in which the wires holding him together broke and had to be redone. A little later, I fell and shattered my right ankle. It was inoperable and amputated. We have coped the best we could.
