2017-2018 HNOJ Sunday Faith Formation Calendar Overview

There are a total of 22 sessions scheduled for the 2017-2018 school year, and five special Wednesday evening family events. Below is an explanation of Calendar Key Notations found on the visual side of this calendar.

Class in Session:

Any grey box on the calendar denotes a date when class is in session. Please plan to have child(ren) attend class on these dates. Parents will receive a postcard in the mail the week of September 17 listing their child's teachers and class location. Students will receive books and other class materials when attending the first class session on September 24.

Catechist Training:

Time must be set aside to ensure that Catechists are properly trained and prepared to lead Faith Formation classes at HNOJ. Catechists will receive more information about this session via email.

Family Activity at HNOJ:

Any grey box with the letters 'FA' replacing the date indicates a special event taking place which families are invited to participate in together. Activities planned for this year include an Operation Christmas Child Party, a Holy Name Against Hunger Food Packing Evening, a Lenten evening and Faith Formation student hosted liturgies. At any Faith Formation student hosted liturgy, students in the Faith Formation program will be selected to volunteer in several ministries including greeting, processing, lecturing and proclaiming the prayers of intercession. More information about each event will be sent via email during the program year.

MEA, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Martin Luther King, President's Day and Spring Breaks:

These breaks are a standard in the Faith Formation program to keep our calendars as closely aligned as possible with school calendars used in the districts our students reside in: Delano, Orono, Osseo, Robbinsdale and Wayzata.

Daylight Savings Break:

Classes are not in session on Sunday, March 11 when Daylight Savings Time begins so students have time to acclimate to the time adjustment.

Easter Sunday:

Classes are not in session on Sunday, April 1 so all families can enjoy Easter Sunday together.

Luke 18 Retreat:

The Luke 18 Retreat, designed for students in seventh and eighth grade, takes place on campus the weekend of October 27, 28 and 29. We will not hold class sessions during this weekend so our seventh and eighth graders can get the most out of their retreat.
