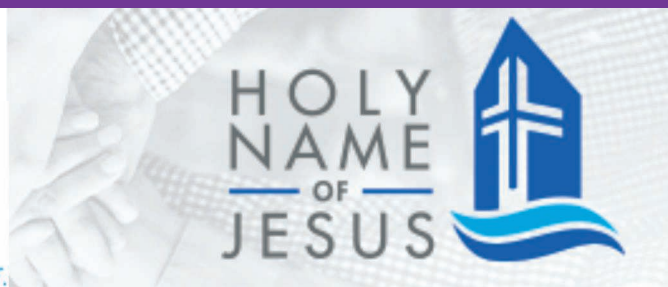

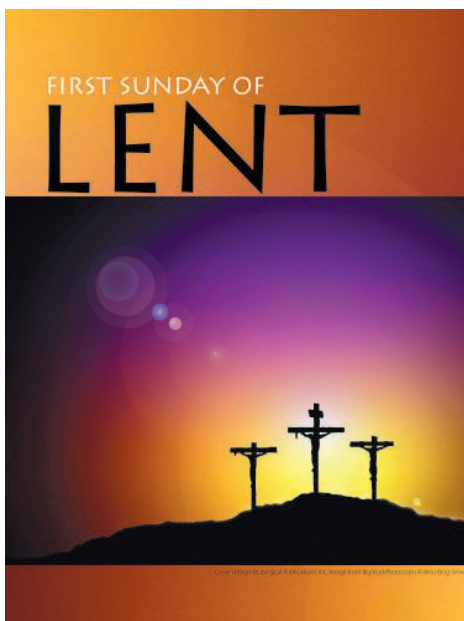

NPH Mission Trip - Dominican Republic - August 2018

**Applications due in full Wednesday, Feb. 21.*

This summer teens and adults from HNOJ will travel to the Casa Santa Ana, in the Dominican Republic, a home in the Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos system of orphanages.

While at the house, we will put on a VBS experience for 6-8 year-olds during the day and spend our afternoons and evenings giving attention to children who desperately need it. Each night we take some time to reflect on our day's activities and how we experienced God in the most vulnerable and marginalized. There are a limited number of spots on the trip.



The HNOJ NPH Mission Trip is a 6-month experience. From application to reunion we ask all participants and chaperones to commit to every aspect of the experience. Prep meetings beginning in Feb./March. We also hold significant fundraising for the children from the beginning to the end of the preparation process. These fundraisers are necessary and important.

The dates of the trip are Sunday, July 29 - Aug. 5. The cost is \$1000.

The Application (in full) is due at the end of the day Feb. 21. Please don't wait until the last minute as travel documents with signatures are needed for the application.

To apply, download the application from www.hnoj.org/nph-mission-trip, completing the forms, and returning them to HNOJ by Feb. 21.

Funeral Ministers Needed

"Blessed are they who mourn, for they will be comforted." (Matthew 5:4)

Holy Name of Jesus celebrates an average of 35-40 funerals annually. If you have experienced the death of a loved one you understand how important the prayers, care and support of your faith community are. Holy Name of Jesus has a dedicated group of parishioners that make themselves available to serve families in their time of grief. We are currently in need of volunteers to serve as Acolytes and Sacristans.

Sacristans prepare items used during the funeral Mass including hosts, wine, communion vessels, linens, etc. This preparation takes place about thirty minutes before the start of the liturgy. Sacristans also serve as Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion when needed. After Mass, the Sacristan puts away the items used in their proper storage place.



Acolytes aid the Presider during various parts of the liturgy. Duties include carrying the Processional Cross in at the beginning and end of the Mass, assisting the Presider with the Presentation of Gifts, lighting charcoal and placing incense in the thurible for incensing, and serving as Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion when needed. All of those involved in the funeral ministry participate as needed. It is an on-call ministry that usually takes place in mid-morning. Training is provided.  (Ps 25:4)*
