



Pastoral Care: Ministry of the Sick

Holy Name is blessed with a host of lay volunteers, who are eager to visit the sick and the homebound in order to offer them comfort, prayer, companionship and a listening ear. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are also able to bring our Eucharistic Lord to those who are unable to be present for Holy Mass, so that those suffering from pain and loneliness can know their closeness to their Suffering Lord. In these and other important ways, the faithful of our parish continue the work of Christ.



In the past it was easier to accomplish this important work, as hospitals and care facilities would ordinarily notify local parishes if one of their members was admitted to their care. However, with recent privacy restrictions, these lines of communication have been cut off. Fortunately, most hospitals have a priest assigned to care for catholic patients. At the same time, we rely more than ever on the charity of friends and family to let us know when one of their loved ones is in need. If you know someone who sick, homebound or approaching the end of life, please let us know by contacting our office or Fr. Evans so that we can do our best to serve those in need.

Special mention should also be made of emergency situations, when due to extreme illness or imminent danger of death, there is a more urgent need for priestly care. There are special gifts that only a priest can give in such hours, and the priests of Holy Name make it a top priority to attend to those in crisis situation. So please do not hesitate to notify us. Our emergency line for *after-hours* calls is 763-233-0259.

Watchfire Begins Holy Thursday

Holy Name of Jesus's Watchfire is tended by parishioners beginning Holy Thursday Night until the start of the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. Holy Thursday - March 29

Presentation of the holy oils, community foot washing and the lighting of our watchfire are highlights of this Eucharistic celebration.

- 7 p.m. Mass of the Lord's Supper (Nursery Available)

What happens at a Watchfire? Starting with the lighting of the fire at the end of the Holy Thursday liturgy and ending with the Easter Vigil, a watchfire is tended by volunteer groups who pray, sing, watch and wait together. Sign-up sheets with two-hour intervals will be in the Good Samaritan Center.

The church will be open all day for prayer and reflection. The following activities are offered. Please feel free to come and go as your schedule allows.

The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night - March 31

Holy Saturday continues our waiting until the Easter Vigil, when we celebrate Jesus' passage from death to life. RCIA elect and candidates become full members during this liturgy, followed by a celebration reception. Bring bells to the Easter Vigil to ring during the Gloria. Note: This Mass is about two and a half hours long.



In-Processing Volunteer for Resale Select - Accept and sort incoming clothing, shoes, accessories and household items. Hang and size clothing in preparation for merchandise pricing. Middle school students welcome with an adult. Morning and afternoon shifts available, Tuesday-Saturday.

Drivers for Students - Provide scheduled rides in driver-owned vehicle for adults taking English classes or children going to preschool (with a parent). Don't let transportation get in the way of their education. Students all live close by, in our service area, and will get dropped off at our building for classes. One ride/week, daytime hours.
