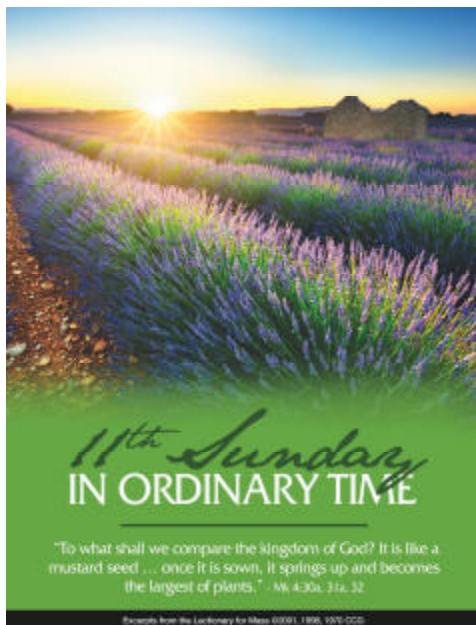

## Knights of Columbus Holy Family Icon

The Knights of Columbus Holy Family Icon will be on display in the Adoration Chapel between June 12 and June 20.

This icon is the centerpiece of the Knights of Columbus sponsored Holy Family Prayer Program which was initiated in 2015 during the Knights of Columbus Supreme Convention in Philadelphia. The program recognizes the vital role of families in the world and the importance of strengthening Catholic families and their prayer lives.

This is one of seven icons being transferred among parishes within the State of Minnesota by the Knights of Columbus. They were blessed by Pope Francis while recalling the words of Pope John Paul II *"The future of the world and of the Church passes through the family."*



### Rummage Sale Volunteer Opportunity

It is not too late to volunteer at our parish rummage sale, which is THIS week. It is easy to volunteer: you do not need to commit to tons of hours, just come when you can and work as much as you like. Please sign in in the GSC when you arrive and out when you leave. Committee members or seasoned volunteers can orient you to the sale and get you started if you are new to volunteering. And we serve free lunches and snacks to keep you nourished and happy!

- We will need lots of help setting up for the sale June 17-20. We'll be setting up the displays and shelving starting at 12 p.m. on Sunday. Some strong folks to help move these heavy materials out from storage would be so appreciated. Yes, we know it's Father's Day; it's a great activity to do with your older kids and you will *really* appreciate that steak and cold beverage after an afternoon at the sale set-up. On Monday and Tuesday, we will work 9 a.m.-7 p.m. and Wednesday from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Sorting, organizing and pricing this sale is a big effort and also lots of fun. All volunteers who give eight hours of their time to set-up are eligible to attend a private presale Wednesday evening from 5-7 p.m. **NEW THIS YEAR:** If you sign a pledge to work eight hours during the sale OR four hours during clean-up, you may also come to the pre-sale.
- During the sale we need cashiers during all our open hours: Thursday, 9 a.m.-8 p.m., Friday, 9 a.m.-6 p.m., Saturday, 8 a.m.-12 noon. Please consider offering a few hours during the later times of the day when the morning cashiers are getting tired. Cashiering is one job you can do if you are not able to lift and carry heavy things or be on your feet for hours. We also need carry-out help, and folks to keep reorganizing the merchandise. We always

need large shopping bags, so you can donate those, too.

- We *really* appreciate volunteers who bring food for the helpers (sandwich fixings, snacks, pop, salads and desserts are all terrific). Food donations can be dropped off in the kitchen anytime all week and Carol Jordan and her crew will happily accept whatever you have to offer.
- Clean-up on Saturday afternoon is also a big effort; we will need lots of folks who can help out, beginning at noon and ending around 3 p.m. The Salvation Army and the DAV are bringing trucks to pick up most of the remains. Some items will also be donated to other organizations. If you can take a load to Bridging, Goodwill or ARC that afternoon, we would so appreciate you loading up your car or truck around 1-3 p.m.
- If you volunteer at the sale, you will be invited to a volunteer appreciation family picnic on June 26. Look for details at the sale. Grand fun!
