


Prayer Request

That is why the angel, Gabriel, referred to her as "full of grace" when he greeted her (Lk 1:28). John the Baptist was freed from this sin in the womb of his mother, Elizabeth, when Mary visited her in her pregnancy (Lk 1:41).


