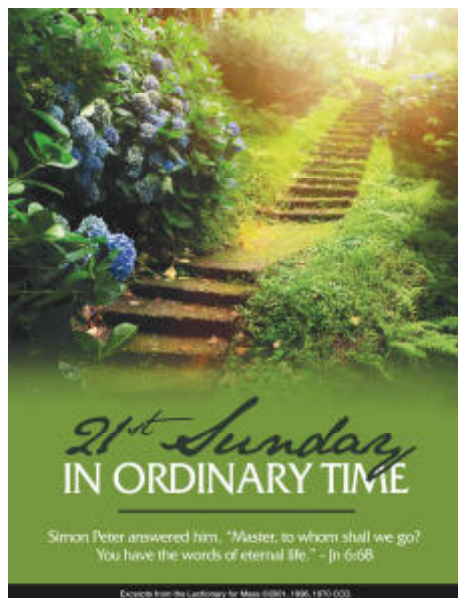

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is starting up. We will begin with Inquiry Sessions as follows:

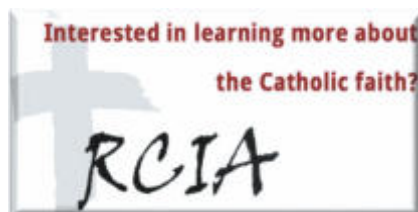
Sunday, Aug. 26, after the 5:30 p.m. Mass
