





Scripture of the Week

By the world's standards, it would not be wise to sell all we have and give to the poor. Yet, this is what Jesus tells the man who is lacking one thing. Jesus, who may be thought of as THE Wisdom of God (see Prov 8:22-36), knows that the wisdom of God is greater than the wisdom of man.

Jesus, who is also the very Word of God, is able to penetrate between the soul and the spirit, discerning the thoughts of the heart. He was able to discern that, despite the fact that the man who approached Him was *observing* the law, he was not truly *living* the law. The point of the law is love - love of God AND love of neighbor. Only when we observe the law out of love, will we have treasure in heaven. We need to ask ourselves, "Am I living the law out of love - for God and for others?"


