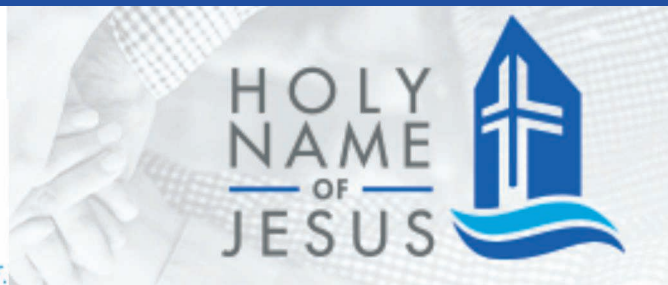

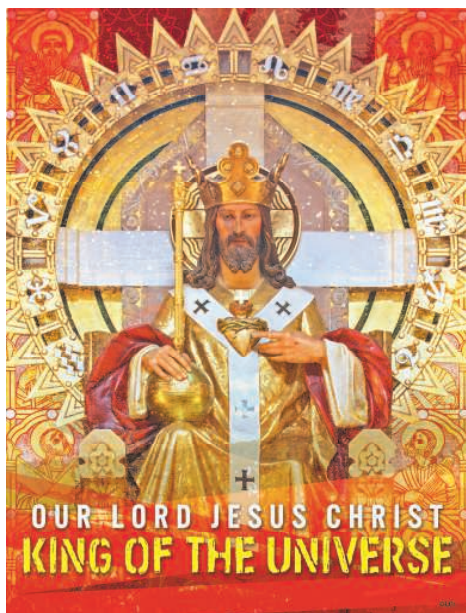

Fifty Years on the Family: A Look Back to the Present

A Saint John's School of Theology and Seminary Theology Day

Presenter: Kari-Shane Davis Zimmerman, Ph.D.

Over the past fifty years, familial life has evolved in response to the "signs of the time." Changes within marriage and gender roles, as well as expectations regarding men and women's relationship to work have moved the family unit into uncharted territory.
