- The IRS requires that checks must be received by Dec. 31 or earlier in order to be credited to the 2018 tax year.
- Gifts of appreciated stock enable you to make a contribution and maximize your tax benefit. Stocks must be transferred by Dec. 31 for credit in tax year 2018. Please notify the parish office prior to any stock transfer so that we can ensure your transfer and gift receipt are handled properly.
- Check with your employer to determine whether a *matching gift* from your company can double the value of your contribution to HNOJ School!
- Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs) from an IRA account may provide tax benefits. Contact your financial advisor if you wish to make a charitable gift from your account. If you do make such a distribution, please notify us so that we can provide you with a receipt that meets IRS requirements.

### Scripture of the Week



"Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice!"  
(Phil 4:4)

Rejoice! That is the theme of this third Sunday of Advent. The prophet Zephaniah tells his listeners to do this because the King of Israel, the Lord, is in their midst. Saint Paul echoes this message to the community of Philippi telling them to rejoice *always* - because the Lord is near to them. John the Baptist preaches the good news, the reason to rejoice, to the people.

The good news is that God, in His infinite love, has always been with us. He is with us now. He will be with us forever. His love is so great, that He stooped to become one of us so that we could be one with Him forever.
