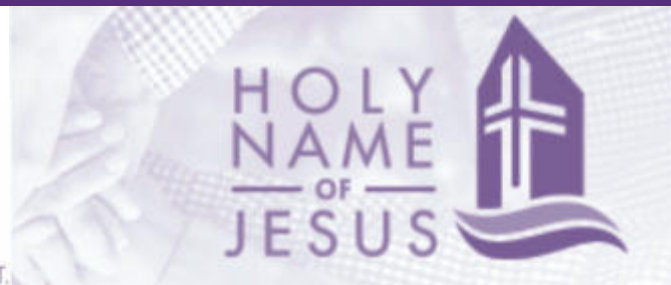

### HNOJ Members Embark for Italy Dec. 29

At the end of December, 52 travelers from Holy Name of Jesus will embark on a seven-day pilgrimage to Italy. A pilgrimage is a journey to a sacred destination. This journey will allow our travelers to encounter God in a new and profound way. During our travels we will pause each day for Mass in different churches. Our choir members will experience glorifying God by singing in some very beautiful spaces both visually and acoustically.

Our pilgrimage will begin in Assisi, the birthplace of St. Francis and St. Clare, founders of the Franciscan and Poor Clare's religious orders. We will celebrate Mass in the Basilica of St. Francis on New Year's Day. A day excursion to Florence, in the heart of Tuscany, will include Michelangelo's masterpiece, David, the famous Duomo, and the Basilica of Santa Croce where we will celebrate Mass. The conclusion of our week in Rome will include touring Ancient Roman sights of the Roman Forum and Colosseum. The Vatican Museums and St. Peter's Basilica will definitely be a highlight in the eternal city. Visits to the Christian Rome sights will include the St. John Lateran Basilica, and St. Mary Major.

The Italy choir will join the Sistine Chapel choir to sing at a public Mass on Friday evening at St. Peter's. Attending the Pontifical Mass for the Epiphany will conclude our time in Rome. Our travelers will be led by Holy Name of Jesus staff members: Fr. Steve Ulrick, Pastor and Spiritual Director; Mary Kay Knapp, Choir Director; and Judy Hodgson, Director of Music. Our Italy Choir is made up of a combination of all of our adult choirs at Holy Name of Jesus, including the Adult, Contemporary and Praise Choirs. We will also be joined by other members of the Holy Name of Jesus faith community and several guests. The choir will sing a farewell Mass on Saturday, Dec. 29, at 5 p.m. Please pray for safety during our travels and for a blest and grace filled trip.

- **Coffee and Donuts (returns on Dec. 30):** After our regular 8:30 and 10:30 a.m. Masses, we invite you to come to the Good Samaritan Center (across from the worship space) and enjoy coffee, donuts and great conversation with others in our community.
- **Nursery (returns next week):** Children of all ages are welcome at Mass—indeed, these youngsters help us to recall Jesus' very words, "Let the children come to me... for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these" (Matthew 19:14). Our nursery is another option for parents of children ages eight months and up, where children can play and learn about God while parents are celebrating Mass. Our nursery is open during the regular 8:30 and 10:30 a.m. Sunday Masses.
