

Baking for Babies Cinnamon Roll Event, Next Weekend!

A Community Caring for Life (ACCL) will bake and sell freshly-made cinnamon rolls after Masses Jan. 21 and 22, for a free-will donation to support organizations that serve and protect mothers and their unborn babies.

This will be the thirty-first year the ACCL has put on this event. The tradition started in January because it's the same month and anniversary of the Roe vs. Wade decision, when the Supreme Court legalized abortion on demand in all 50 states in 1973.

We celebrate the June 24, 2022 Supreme Court ruling



placing the writing and enforcement of abortion legislation on individual states. ACCL members expect there will be a greater need to support pro-life organizations in Minnesota now because of our pro-choice leadership and their lack of interest in supporting life-centered organizations.

This year's Baking for Babies event at Holy Name of Jesus will support Abria, SouthWest Options for Women, Robbinsdale Women's Center and Pro-Life Action Ministries.



Scripture of the Week



"'I will make you a light to the nations, that My salvation may reach to the ends of the earth.""

(Isaiah 49:6)

The theme of servanthood is prevalent in today's Scriptures. In Isaiah we hear the second of four "Servant Songs" which ultimately is a call to a new Exodus, to be lead by God Himself in the person of Jesus - "a light for all the nations". In our Second Reading we hear Paul say he is "called to be a disciple of Christ Jesus by the Will of God."

Finally, we hear from St. John in the Gospel about the change in the ministry of John the Baptist, following the occasion of last week's Gospel where Jesus told John to baptize Him; and John will take servanthood a step further by saying that Jesus is the Son of God. It is Jesus's sacrifice that allows us to be Baptized in the "blood of the Lamb" and in that act, invites us to be sons and daughters of the Father. Jesus is the one God promised as His salvation in our First Reading. How are we helping make His name known "to the ends of the earth?"

The Respect Life Mass will be at noon on Jan. 22, at the Cathedral of St. Paul. This Mass commemorates the millions of lives lost to abortion and the many women and men wounded by abortion's aftermath. 
