Scripture of the Week



"The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom should I fear?" (Psalm 27:1)

Last week's theme of servanthood transforming into sonship through salvation in Jesus is repeated in today's Psalm. And it takes it a step further - the position of son or daughter of the Father allows us to ask that we can dwell in His house forever - "one thing I ask of the Lord ... to dwell in the house of the Lord."

This is precisely what Jesus is calling us to - He calls disciples in today's Gospel, but He is still calling disciples today. In the Gospel, they respond by leaving behind all they had to follow Him. Can we dare to do the same? Can we truly pray the prayer that never fails and become disciples today? Pray that prayer every day for it transforms us to be ready for discipleship - "Thy will be done."
