

All fine dining meals are free-will donations. This is especially helpful for families attending Faith Formation. All are






#### **Small Group Host/Leader Training**



### Scripture of the Week



"Rejoice, and be glad, for your reward will be great in Heaven."

(Matthew 5:12a)

In our First Reading, the prophet Zephaniah tells the people of Judah to "seek the Lord." The time for Judah as a free kingdom is nearing the end and the prophet writes to offer hope to the Judaean people when there appears to be little hope left for them. He reminds them that God will leave a remnant of faithful people. Such is the message of St. Paul in our Second Reading. Despite what the people believe themselves to lack, Paul reminds them that God can, in the end, draw straight with crooked lines, as the saying goes.

To what end? This is where Jesus's words during His first public sermon come in! As recorded by St. Matthew in our Gospel, we hear a portion of the Sermon on the Mount, known as the Beatitudes. Like Zephaniah, Jesus instructs the people that things may not always be what they seem. He offers hope for people caught in suffering, to the downtrodden, to the poor. There is more to their lives, and ours, than we see at first glance. Jesus speaks hope to them and us. Hope to save us when we have turned away from God and can no longer make the journey back on our own. Hope is no longer a mere thing; hope is a person and His name is Jesus.


