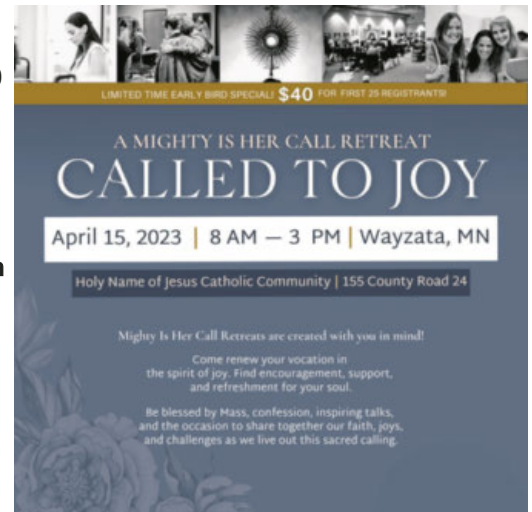
Women's Retreat, Registration is Open!

Calling ALL women! With Lent around the corner, many of us are focused on setting goals for the 40 days leading up to Easter. Then what? Consider making the most of this Easter season by setting aside a half-day to explore the concept of joy. **Holy Name of Jesus will be hosting a women's retreat led by Mighty is Her Call on Saturday, April 15, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. The cost is \$45 with an early-bird discounted price of \$40 for the first 25 registrants. Mighty is Her Call (MIHC) is a fast-growing Catholic women's ministry based in Dallas, Texas. Their ministry primarily works to support and nourish mothers in their vocation, but the focus isn't as narrow as one might think. At HNOJ, we are inviting all women ages 22-102 to come together. This retreat will not cater to a specific age or life-stage; instead, we hope to provide an intergenerational retreat experience where we can embrace our shared identity as Daughters of God. As MIHC describes the retreat experience, "It's a chance for you to reflect on the importance of your vocation, to relax and to remember just how powerful, meaningful and Christ-filled your life is."

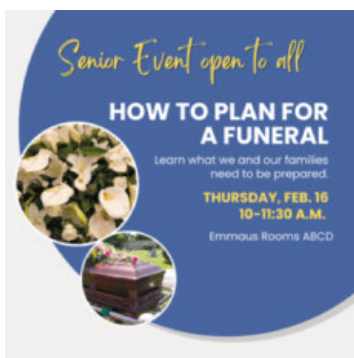

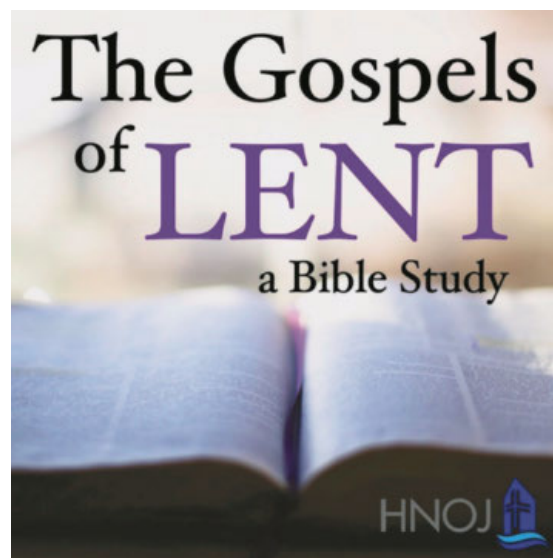

Scripture of the Week



“Before man are life and death, good and evil, whichever he chooses shall be given him.”

(Sirach 15:16)

In this week’s Gospel Reading we hear Jesus say that He has come to fulfill the Law of Moses, not to abolish it. And then He calls us deeper into the mystery of the Law by encouraging us to live the Law not so much as an action but as an acceptance of it into our hearts. What matters most is not just about how we act, but how we truly embrace the commandments.

This is the ultimate choice Sirach speaks of in the First Reading. The choices we make, we make first in our hearts. Either remaining faithful OR choosing to sin - both begin with a movement of the heart. Paul’s words in the Second Reading point to this too, “What eye has not seen, and ear has not heard and what has not entered the human heart...this has God revealed to us through the Spirit.”
