



Scripture of the Week



"Before man are life and death, good and evil, whichever he chooses shall be given him."

(Sirach 15:16)

In this week's Gospel Reading we hear Jesus say that He has come to fulfill the Law of Moses, not to abolish it. And then He calls us deeper into the mystery of the Law by encouraging us to live the Law not so much as an action but as an acceptance of it into our hearts. What matters most is not just about how we act, but how we truly embrace the commandments.

This is the ultimate choice Sirach speaks of in the First Reading. The choices we make, we make first in our hearts. Either remaining faithful OR choosing to sin - both begin with a movement of the heart. Paul's words in the Second Reading point to this too, "What eye has not seen, and ear has not heard and what has not entered the human heart...this has God revealed to us through the Spirit."
