Rite of Christian Initiation at Holy Name of Jesus

"The world is thy ship, not thy home" (Saint Therese of Lisieux). Therese tells us that our time on Earth is temporal, and not our end goal — union with Christ in heaven is. However, it is the first part of this quote that strikes me. The analogy of the ship got me thinking; what is needed for a ship to sail? It needs a group of people all contributing to different areas with one goal — to sail. This indicates to me that faith is meant to be lived in a community. We are meant to share Christ with each other as He is our goal.

Since the fall, there have been 24 individuals praying, studying, learning, growing and encountering the Catholic faith. These 24 have demonstrated courageous faith, beautiful openness of heart and total vulnerability. During our time together, we have become a family. We have come to know each other, relate to each other and lean on each other. We have two different groups in RCIA this year: kids and adults. Our adult class is filled with lots of laughter and lively small group discussions. Our kids' group is comprised of children who all have such a passionate desire to receive their Sacraments.

In learning more about Christ and the Catholic Church together, we are all growing. This includes our Catechumens (those not yet baptized), Candidates (those who have already been baptized seeking full communion in the Catholic Church), Sponsors (those who have a special role to support and accompany either their Catechumen or Candidate) and everyone else involved in our RCIA team of support. This growth includes: growing closer to God, each other, the Catholic Church, particular Saints and to the Holy Name of Jesus Parish specifically.

Through being involved in RCIA, I have been very struck by the truth that we are indeed one Body in Christ. All 24 have come into RCIA with completely different life situations, but they are all unified in their one desire - Christ. At this year's Easter Vigil, they will be receiving the Sacraments of Baptism (if they have not yet already been Baptized), first Eucharist and Confirmation. Please pray for these 24 individuals, their Sponsors, their families and for our RCIA Team. May we continue to sail onwards toward Christ, united in that goal as one family!



Fasting and Abstinence during Lent

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years until age 59. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years and older.

Stations of the Cross

Stations of the Cross are held most Fridays in Lent at 6:30 p.m, except for the dates of the Passion Play and Fish Fry meals. See the full schedule at hnoi.org/lent.



"Be holy, for I, the Lord, your God, am Holy." (Leviticus 19:2b)

This week we hear the author of Leviticus call us to be holy as God is holy. We also hear Paul tell us that we are temples of the Spirit of God, and Jesus call us to "be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect." This expands on the messages from last week calling us to a conversion of heart. For this is how we can be holy, this is how we can truly be living temples, this is how we can be perfect - love, and do so perfectly.

What does perfect love look like? No place and in no thing is the look of perfect love more evident than to gaze upon Jesus on His cross. In the book of Romans, we hear that "while we were still sinners, He died for us." This is the transformation of the heart then, to die to self in order that we are free to truly love others. don'ts" and how the Archbishop emphasized small groups in his recent Pastoral Letter.






