

Vacation Bible School 2023 - The Great Investigation!

Are you ready to go on a top-secret mission? VBS registration for 2023 is now open! Please check our VBS website at hnoj.org/vbs for the registration form.

What is VBS? Vacation Bible School is a four-day faith-filled AND fun-filled adventure for participants of ages four through those entering 5th grade in the fall of 2023! Participants who will be four in the fall and are potty trained are eligible to register at the preschool level. During the four days, VBS will investigate specific Bible stories. Each day participants will attend four centers that emphasize the Bible story so they can grow in their understanding as we help bring the Bible story to life in a child-friendly way. How much does it cost to attend VBS? The cost is \$45 per participant. Our registration deadline is May 19, 2023. Any registrations received after May 19 will be charged a \$5 late fee.






