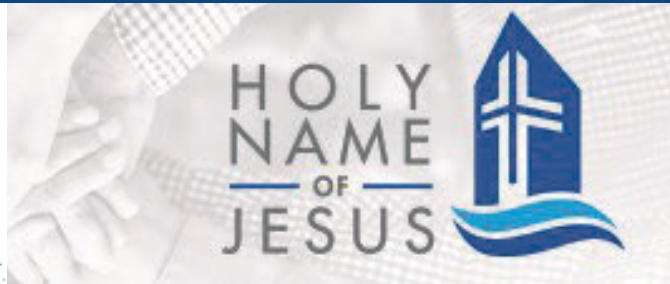

Vacation Bible School 2023 - The Great Investigation!

June 12 -15, from 8:30 a.m. to Noon

Are you ready to go on a top-secret mission? VBS registration for 2023 is now open! Please check our VBS website at hnoj.org/vbs for the registration form.

What is VBS? Vacation Bible School is a four-day faith-filled AND fun-filled adventure for participants of ages four through those entering 5th grade in the fall of 2023! Participants who will be four in the fall and are potty trained are eligible to register at the preschool level. During the four days, VBS will investigate specific Bible stories. Each day participants will attend four centers that emphasize the Bible story so they can grow in their understanding as we help bring the Bible story to life in a child-friendly way. More information on specific centers is on the website!

How much does it cost to attend VBS? The cost is \$45 per participant. Our registration deadline is May 19, 2023. Any registrations received after May 19 will be charged a \$5 late fee.

Vacation Bible School, Volunteers Needed!

With that, we can't have Vacation Bible School without volunteers! We need energetic and faith-filled teens and adults who would like to share their love of Christ with the participants by volunteering to lead them through the week.

Teens who are entering 6th grade and older are invited to apply to serve as a VBS volunteer. Applications are online at hnoj.org/vbs. Applications will be due by May 19, 2023! Those who have applied will be contacted via email within a week of receiving the application to inform you if your application has been accepted.

Adults who are 18 years of age can register online to serve as a volunteer by using the Adult Volunteer Form found at hnoj.org/vbs. We are seeking adults to serve as leaders in the various VBS centers. Adults are also needed to serve as Group Leaders and Nurses. Scripture of the Week



"Were not our hearts burning within us while He spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?"

(Luke 24:32)

The road to Emmaus is one of the most familiar stories told of Jesus's disciples seeing Him after the resurrection. Cleopas and another disciple are dejected, worn out and, one may assume, trudging the seven miles back to Emmaus after they witnessed the Passion and death of Jesus - not at all the "exciting events" they had expected to see from Jesus after His triumphal entry into Jerusalem just a week before.

And then, when they went to visit the tomb after the Sabbath, they were disappointed again on finding it desecrated - or so they believed. The stone was rolled away, and the body was nowhere to be found. Now, exhausted and spent, they head towards home and along the way encounter a person who they do not recognize, but who proceeds to interpret "all the Scripture" to them. Recognition was still slow to come!

Reaching their home, they invite the stranger in to share the evening meal. When He takes the bread, says the blessing, breaks it and hands it to them they see Jesus Himself present before them. Friends, this is our reality every time we participate in Mass. Jesus Himself is present before us. Do we find the same faith of the two from Emmaus and really see Jesus present before us in the breaking of the Bread?

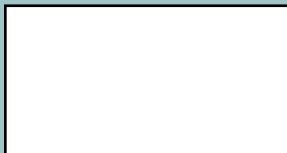
