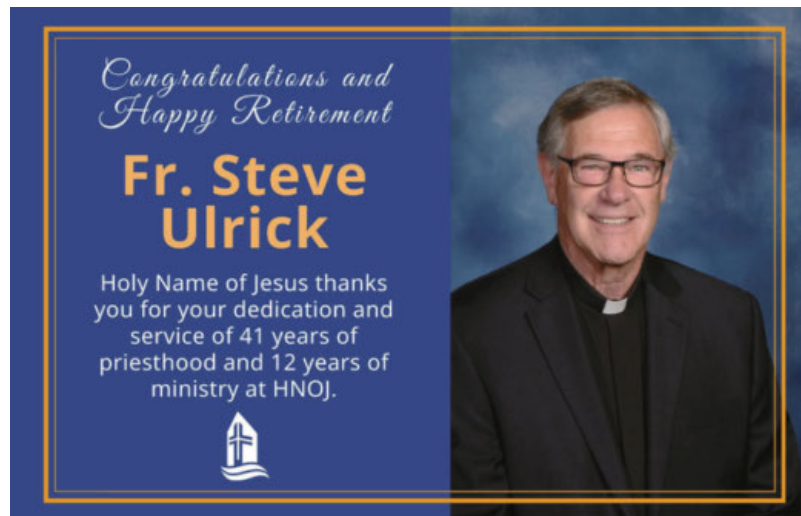

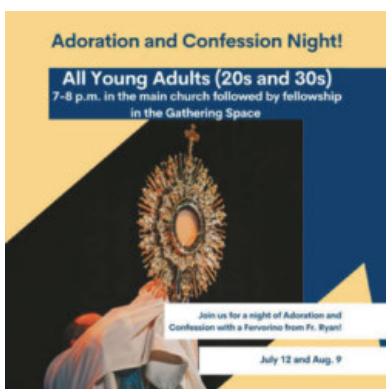

Scripture of the Week



*“Jesus said to the Twelve:
“Fear no one.”
(Matthew 10:26a)*

Fear is a powerful motivator. In our First Reading we hear how Jeremiah hears whisperings, terror and denouncements - all things to fear. And yet, he says “But the Lord is with me, like a mighty Champion”. St. Paul in our Second Reading speaks of death entering the world through the transgression of one man - Adam - but the “grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ overflows for many.”

There are so many things to fear in today's world. Or are there? St. Matthew tells us that not a single sparrow falls to the ground without the Father's knowledge and then says: “So do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father.” It is our choice; we can submit to fear or live with the promise of eternal life with our Father in heaven. Which do you choose?

Still others, although surrounded by family and friends, have no one to talk with them about the love and mercy of Jesus Christ. Many people will not call for a priest when their loved one is dying. Also, so many people simply deny the stark truth about their mortality until time has run out. How great their sorrow and fear as they face death unprepared, just moments away from seeing God, the Just Judge! 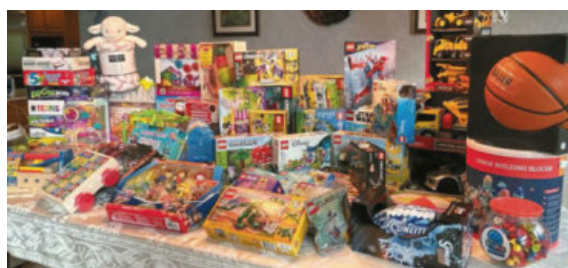

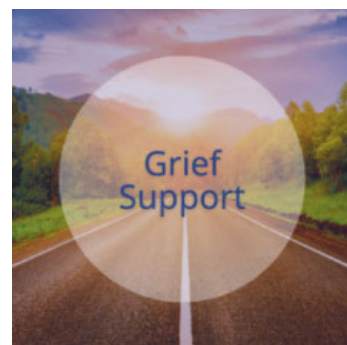


West Suburban Grief Coalition, Thursdays

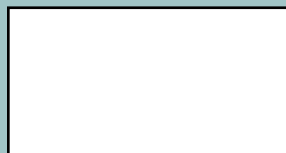
