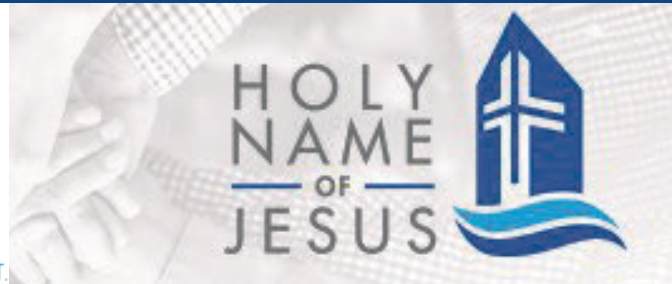

Freedom

Happy Independence Day! 247
years ago, our Founding Fathers
signed the Declaration of
Independence, bringing about the
symbolic birth of the United States
founded fundamentally on the
principle of “freedom.”

It is often the case that we consider
freedom as simply being free “from”
something. Teenagers may desire
freedom from following their parents’
or teachers’ rules. Adults may desire
freedom from having to pay their bills
or from having too many
responsibilities at work. The elderly
may desire freedom from any
physical or mental effects of aging.
It seems that a desire for freedom is
hardwired into the human condition.

But what does the Church say about
freedom? Contrary to those who think the Catholic Church is all about
discipline and rules, the Church actually affirms that freedom is a good thing!
While society today seems to advocate for a radical “freedom from” many of
the social norms that have historically served society, the freedom preached
by Christ is a “freedom for.” The freedom God offers us is “a force for growth
and maturity in truth and goodness; it attains its perfection when directed
toward God, our beatitude.” (Catechism of the Catholic Church #1731). God
beckons to us, calls out to us, is always inviting us to a deeper relationship
with Him and with our brothers and sisters. God does not want us to be His
slaves, but has given us the true freedom of the children of God.” (Romans
8:21). The gift of freedom God offers is a choice between His ways or those
of darkness.

Compared to much of the world, the United States still offers a considerable
amount of religious freedom. As we celebrate our country’s independence
during these days, let us be sure to use that great gift to live out a “freedom
for” choosing God.

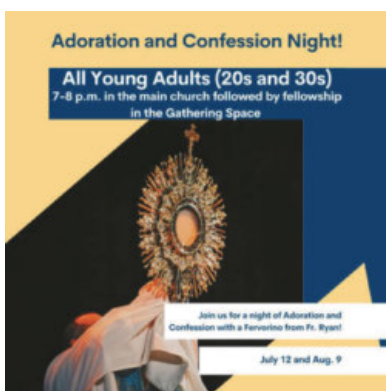

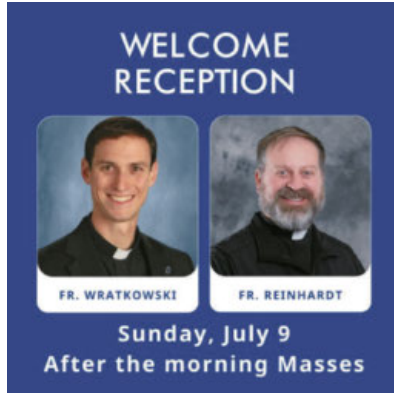

Scripture of the Week



"Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me" (Matthew 10:40)

Both our First Reading and our Gospel this weekend speak of receiving a guest - of hospitality. We here at Holy Name of Jesus pride ourselves on this principle and the heritage of living it out as part of our Benedictine tradition. Today as never before, our world needs this grace, this gift of hospitality. And yet, it may not always be without some cost. St. Paul in today's Second Reading reminds us that "we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death."

Yet, if we die with Him we also live with Him. This is the promise of Matthew's words to the disciples - "whoever receives you receives me." And Jesus goes on to explain that by accepting Him we also accept His Father. Back in my days at seminary in the 1970's and 80's, a common joke was that once we were ordained (IF we were ordained), the pay wouldn't be much, but the retirement would be heavenly.

Please, Jesus, let us all live lives of hospitality that merit a "heavenly retirement" - no joke!

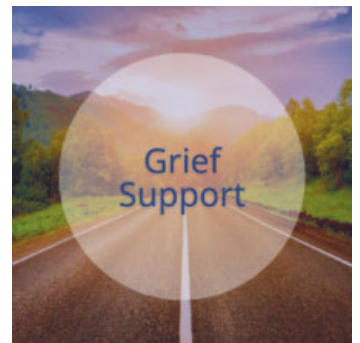

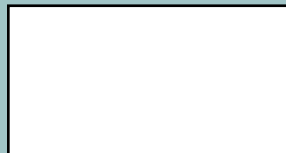
