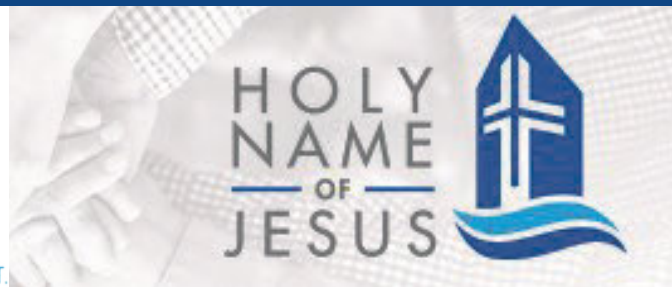

Mass Isn't Boring, You're Just Bored at Mass

We've all been bored at Mass. It's tragic, but it has unfortunately been the reality for many faithful Catholics over the years. Too often, we become passive spectators; we sit, stand and kneel on cue, we hope the homily will end soon, we hope the music fits our personal preferences and we hope that Mass ends in under an hour, assuming we stay to the end at all.

This was certainly my attitude for much of my life. Yet when I was in college, I had the Mass opened up to me and explained to me in a new way, and it forever changed my engagement and participation. All throughout seminary, my interest and desire to learn more about the liturgy kept growing and now I've been blessed with the opportunity to study Liturgical Theology in a specialized program in Rome.

Therefore, I am pleased to announce a five-part lecture series that I will be offering explaining different aspects of the Church's liturgy. The lectures will each be offered once at 10 a.m. and the other at 7 p.m. on Wednesdays, beginning next week. The topics are listed below. While there is no cost to attend, we do kindly ask you to register for any dates you think you might attend to help with our planning purposes. I will present for 45 minutes, allowing plenty of time afterwards for discussion and questions. I hope to see you all there!

Wednesday, Aug. 16: "Vatican II said WHAT?!" (Liturgical Reforms of Vatican II)

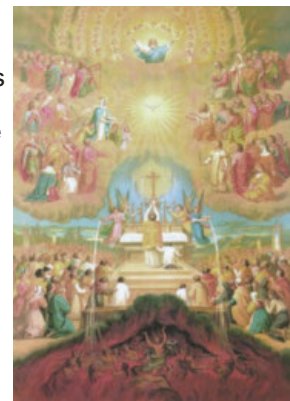
Wednesday, Aug. 23: "Words, Worship, and the Word" (Scripture and the Liturgy)

"But blessed are your eyes, because they see, and your ears, because they hear" (Matthew 13:16)

This week we are encouraged to reflect on the words of sacred Scripture. From Isaiah telling us that the words that go forth from God's mouth shall not return in vain, to Matthew's recounting of Jesus's parable of the sower and the seeds. The seeds representing God's word fall on different soils - representing those who hear.

Some will not understand, some will receive the message gratefully and then immediately forget it, others will hear but not act due to influences from the world around them. Finally Jesus speaks of those who both hear and understand His word bearing fruit from 30 to 60 to 100-fold. 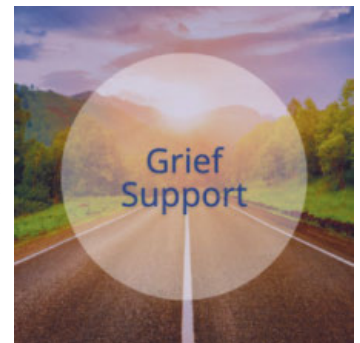

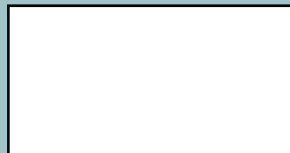
