

New Summer Sacrament Opportunities

In my first two years here, which have been extremely blessed, I have often heard two requests regarding the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Mass. People have asked me, "Can we have another scheduled time for Reconciliation?" And I've also heard, "We used to have a Mass on Saturday morning, can we start that again?" It is edifying for me to hear the spiritual hunger and desire to grow in your faith. Given that we are blessed to have three priests around for the summer, and after consultation with the parish staff and the Liturgy Commission, I am pleased to announce that we will be



adding an additional opportunity for Reconciliation and a Saturday morning daily Mass at least through the summer.

Starting this week, we will be offering the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Wednesdays from 5:15-6:15 p.m., the first day being July 26. We chose an evening time with the hopes that those interested could stop by on their way home from work before dinner time. We know that no time will work for everyone's schedule, but we hope this opportunity will be helpful. In addition, anyone is welcome to set up a private appointment for Reconciliation outside of the regularly scheduled times (through Grace Johnson gjohnson@hnoj.org if you would like to remain anonymous.)

Also, starting this week on July 29, we will be offering a daily Mass on Saturdays at 8 a.m., with the usual Reconciliation to follow at 8:30 a.m. From ancient times, the Church has had a beautiful tradition of dedicating Saturdays to the Blessed Virgin Mary, as on the Saturday between Good Friday and Easter Sunday, the faith of the Church resided in Mary, whose faith did not waver at the foot of the Cross. Therefore, the Church has a rich treasury of Mass formularies dedicated to Mary, and we hope to celebrate some of these Masses on Saturdays which are not impeded by another saint's celebration.

We hope you and your families will join us for these wonderful opportunities to grow in your faith this summer!

Scripture of the Week



"The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought" (Romans 8:26a)

This week we hear three more parables from Jesus: the weeds in the field, the mustard seed and what is often called the parable of the leaven. The first stands apart from the second and third. In each of the latter, something good is represented by something small that affects a larger thing - the mustard seed is tiny, but grows a large plant, the leaven (or yeast) is far less than the measure of flour to make bread, but a small amount leavens the entire batch of bread.

It is the first parable of the weeds in the field that Jesus will go on to explain. The wheat is desired, a good thing, even a necessary thing, but alongside it in the field grows weeds - something undesired. Isn't that true of our daily lives? We desire the good; yet we deal with things that we cannot control that distract or bother us. We are reminded that, in the end, God will sort everything out. Our job is to trust and to stand firm in the field. To simply do (and be) the good that we are called to do.





June through August we are hosting the meetings at Holy Name of Jesus.




