Lent Is About Repentance

After I joined the Catholic Church, it took longer than I care to admit for our Lenten practices to penetrate my thick mind. I remember thinking, after finishing my cheese and sausage pizza, "Oh, it's Lent. And it's Friday. Oops."



We're just a few days into our Lenten journey, and perhaps you have already stumbled, already forgotten that this past Friday was a Friday in Lent or already found yourself in bed without a Lenten prayer. Don't be discouraged!

Lent is not about acing our Lenten practices. It's about repentance, about learning our need for repentance, about learning about our own poverty, about drawing closer to Jesus Christ by journeying as He journeyed.

If you've already stumbled, then you've learned something about your poverty. You've learned something about the ease with which you are distracted or perhaps about the modest amount of willpower you have. You've encountered a personal limitation and found yourself human.

That is an opportunity for repentance! Repent, and believe in the Gospel! Repent and believe that only by turning to Christ Jesus can you walk the road of discipleship. Repent, believe in Jesus, and take that next step with Him humbly, and clinging to His cloak.

Proverbs 24:16 says this: "... for a righteous man falls seven times, and rises again; but the wicked are overthrown by calamity." Even Jesus stumbled and fell on His road to Calvary as He carried His cross. Even Jesus needed help to continue on His path.

As you struggle or stumble through Lent, get back up and keep your eyes on Jesus. Meditate on His words and actions.

"And he fasted forty days and forty nights and afterwards he was hungry." Matthew 4:2

"If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me." Luke 9:23

"And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me." Matthew 25:40

Scripture of the Week




"Repent, and believe in the Gospel." (Mark 1:15)

Our First Reading from Genesis today hearkens to a new beginning, almost as if creation is starting again. After the flood, humanity and other creatures start from those that were on the ark during the storm. Three years ago, we were entering into a time of uncertainty as a global pandemic was growing. Can we reflect on that time as we begin our journey into Lent to have a sense of what the survivors of the flood faced? Things have changed around us. Have we changed, too?

The true beauty of Lent is its simplicity and silence. It invites us to, as it were, step outside the ark and see the world around us with new eyes as we travel these six Lenten weeks in our journey towards Easter. Jesus's words in today's Gospel gives us the entire roadmap we need for this journey: "Repent, and believe in the Gospel."


