# Grace Notes from the Lenten Small Groups

It is a blessing to hear how the Holy Spirit is moving at Holy Name of Jesus, and I want to share with you two small stories associated with the small groups that began meeting at the beginning of Lent.

One mom, the day after attending the first small group meeting, felt convicted. She got up the following morning and said to herself, "I'm not going to hurry. I'm not going to hurry my kids either." She got out of bed, and her kids got out of bed and (this is a second-hand story, so I'm filling in some details as I imagine them!) they ate breakfast and made their lunches and she



got her kids to school on time. The kids noticed the difference, and one of them asked mom if she had done something different because (and this part I am not paraphrasing) the morning routine had gone so much better. The kid asked, "Mom, what did you do different? Did you do some of the meal preparation last night?" She said, "No, all I did differently was to not yell at you this morning."

Mic drop. What a small change in attitude and posture, and what a huge change in family dynamics! The fruit from being willing to walk together on our faith journey is real!

The second story is quieter, less dramatic, but no less powerful. One lady who joined a small group said that she had been ready to leave the parish until someone invited her to participate in a small group. She said yes and signed up, and she was ever so grateful both for the invitation and for the chance to participate in a small group.

We all hunger for connection, and that connection could be as simple as a smile and a "Hi, how are you?" It could be an invitation, like the invitation to a small group or an invitation to sit down over coffee and a donut in the Good Samaritan Center after Mass. And one of the many great things about these small connections is that they are a blessing to receive and a blessing to give!

These are small stories, but small is good! Small is how the Holy Spirit usually likes to work. I try to be attentive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit to look for these small ways to bless others; when I listen to the Holy Spirit and respond, it never fails to also bless me. And I love to hear about how the Holy Spirit is working in other peoples' lives. Please keep sharing!

Last spring, over 150 women of all ages



# Scripture of the Week




"If God is for us, who can be against us?" (Romans 8:31b)


