Guest Missionary Next Weekend

We look forward to welcoming missionary Fr. John Callan with the Piarist Fathers to Holy Name of Jesus next weekend (Aug. 3-4) so that he can share about the work of his mission. Here is a brief overview from Fr. John:

The Piarist Fathers are a pontifical religious order of priests and brothers. All of our members profess the usual vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. We also profess a special fourth vow to educate the young, particularly the poor.

In our Province of the United States and Puerto Rico, we have 52 members. We work in the Archdioceses of Havana, Miami, New York, Philadelphia,



Quetzaltenango, San Juan and Washington and in the Dioceses of Lexington, Ponce and Tabasco. In these locations, we generally minister in schools and parishes.

Our mission work includes Cuba (one parish, one chapel and one socioeducational center), Guatemala (one parish, 32 chapels and three schools), Mexico (two chapels), Adjuntas, PR (one parish, nine chapels and one school), Lexington, KY (one school) and San Juan, PR (one parish and one school). Each of our mission sites are located in impoverished areas.

We distribute any funds which we receive from the Center for Mission to our six missions. The needs in each mission vary. Generally, they include but are not limited to: evangelization, food, education of youth, occupational skills training, construction projects (schools, churches and latrines), professional preparation of teachers, basic needs (toiletries, medicine), youth ministry (Calasanz Movement), scholarship and tuition assistance, vocations promotion and sacramental ministry in the remote regions of our missions.





"They shall eat and there will be some left over.' And when they had eaten, there was some left over, as the Lord had said" (2 Kings 4:44)

Super-abundance. There is no other way to describe it. For 40 years God fed all of Israel as they wandered in the desert. Today's Gospel shares one of the two different times that Jesus fed enormous crowds with only scarce resources at hand. In our Gospel



reading today we see Jesus being presented with five barley loaves and two fish. The crowd is numbered at 5,000. Jesus blesses the five loaves and two fish and, in the end, twelve baskets of bread fragments are leftover.

Matthew's and Mark's Gospels relate the story of Jesus feeding 4,000 Gentiles with seven loaves and two fish, and all four Gospels relate today's story of Jesus feeding of crowd of 5,000 Jews with five loaves and two fish. Both miraculous feedings result in a superabundance of leftovers. That is God's way; that is God's generosity to His people. The Exodus and Jesus's life are separated by some 1,400+ years, yet in that passage of time, God did not forget His children, nor did He abandon them. His children, both in Moses's time and in Jesus's time, needed God to feed them. And so it is today at each and every Mass - God continues to super-abundantly feed His children.
