

Scripture of the Week



"Put out into the deep water and lower your nets for a catch." (Luke 5:4b)

Our readings today all revolve around being chosen and called. In Isaiah, we hear the Angels singing "Holy, Holy, Holy" and the prophet realizing his own sinful nature but being purified by an Angel and



then called by God - "Whom shall I send?" He then answers, "Here I am, send me." Our Psalm response is "In the sight of the Angels, I will sing your praises, Lord." Our Second Reading from St. Paul tells of his preaching success not because of his own work but because of the grace of God that was with him.

Our Gospel from St. Luke tells the familiar story of the miracle of the full nets - Simon (later to be Peter) has been out fishing all night with no success but Jesus tells him "Put out into the deep water and lower your nets for a catch." As we all know, he did and they did, catching so many fish that both boats were at the point of sinking. Jesus then calls him to follow Him and become fishers of men. That call is still out there - Jesus calls you and me as clearly as He called Peter. And, like Paul we can be successful not because of our own talents or work but because of His grace. But the hard part is simply saying "Yes."
