

Resembling Jesus



What is VBS?

Vacation Bible School is a special four-day faith-filled AND fun-filled time to kick off the summer and get closer to the Lord. Open to kids ages four through 5th grade (entering 5th grade in the fall of 2025), kids will have the opportunity to make friends, craft, sing, play games, pray and learn about God's love, with the Holy Spirit as our guide. Scripture of the Week



"I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, God's dwelling is with the human race. He will dwell with them and they will be his people - and God himself will always be with them as their God." (Revelation 21:3)

Our Second Reading today comes from the Book of Revelation. We like to think that John describes a vision that he was shown of what Heaven will be like. In thinking of what Heaven will be like we are wrong. John is describing what Heaven



IS like. What's the difference some may ask. A most excellent question.

Heaven - and God for that matter - is not a question of a "when" or "will be" but rather a concrete "now". God is not the most powerful being in the Universe, He is beyond the Universe - it is in **Him**, He is not in it. Time is non-existent for God. Again, it is in Him, not Him in it. John saw what Heaven **IS**. What Heaven **IS** in the First Century and what Heaven **IS** today and always. Jesus stepped into time precisely so He could bring us out of time to spend eternity in His presence and that of His Father. God **with us** so we can be with Him.
