Eucharistic Joy

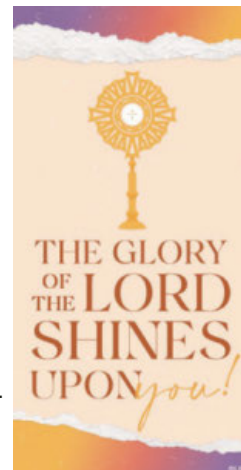
We just finished wrapping up another season of small groups and I have been pleased by one persisting theme: Joy. This should be an obvious consequence since our theme from the past year has been the Holy Eucharist. What on earth could bring more joy than the physical presence of our Lord?? He created us to seek Him, to know Him and to love Him... all while being fully aware that He seeks us first, knows us intimately and loves us unconditionally.

This theme of Eucharistic joy has been especially present in the election of our new Pope – Leo XIV, peace be upon him. From watching him emerge on the loggia at St. Peter's to celebrating his Mass of thanksgiving, it is evident that he is a man animated by a profound love – a love that comes sacramentally from our Lord's body and blood. The teaching is simple: find Christ in the Eucharist and you will be a missionary of joy!

What comes next? You may be jumping up and down with excitement at this newfound or renewed relationship with Jesus through the Eucharist. The answer is found in the words of St. Teresa of Calcutta. When asked how one could feed so many hungry people, she had the simple response to "feed just one." Who in our lives is hungry for more than what this world has to offer? The Holy Spirit is stirring in their hearts longing for them to come into communion. Pray about who this might be and consider your next step. Also ask yourself these questions: "Who has walked with me in my life? What was most effective about the way they did that? Should I invite this person to my small group? Should I invite them to Mass?" Maybe a one-on-one conversation over coffee and/or food is the best start.

We are all called to be missionaries of joy. That joy MUST be rooted in our Lord Jesus Christ and He promises His presence through the Eucharist. I was pleased to hear that the Archdiocesan focus of this next year is going to be reclaiming Sunday. Truly, if our Sunday is rooted in the Eucharist then it will be a day of immense joy, rest and pleasure. Our Lord attracts us back to Him with honey more than discipline. He knows how much we need a day of joy and rest in our often hectic lives. There will be more to come about this but remember that no matter where you're starting from, remember to start with the Eucharist. Let His love convict and inspire joy in your life.

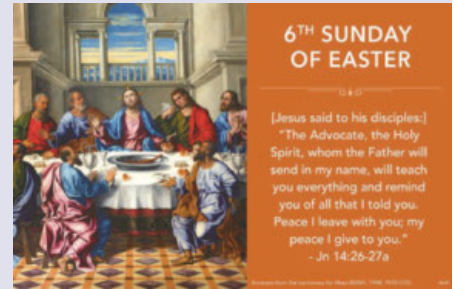


Scripture of the Week



"The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." (John 14:26)

Our readings span both history and mystery today! In our First Reading today, Luke recounts part of the events of the Council of Jerusalem, the very first Council of the Church. Our passage today does not recount Peter's role. The full description shows the apostles presenting different ideas, discussing them and submitting to the words of Peter to set the course. This model of the new apostles (bishops) coming together to discuss and the new Peter (the Pope) promulgating the teaching is the very same form used in councils of the church to this day.



The mystery of Heaven continues to be revealed in our Second Reading from Revelation - the Heavenly Jerusalem is revealed and described. John speaks to the lack of a temple building stating that God Himself is the temple as well as the only light needed to illuminate the city. In our Gospel, the mystery continues for we hear Jesus promise the apostles that the Father will send the Holy Spirit to be with them. And with us.

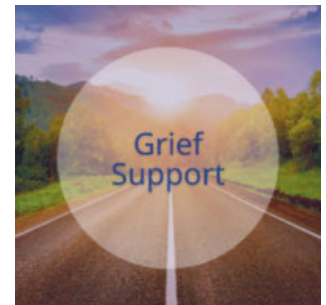


West Suburban Grief Coalition, Thursdays
