


#### **Eucharistic Joy**

passage today does not recount Peter's role. The full description shows the apostles presenting different ideas, discussing them and submitting to the words of Peter to set the course. This model of the new apostles (bishops) coming together to discuss and the new Peter (the Pope) promulgating the teaching is the very same form used in councils of the church to this day.

The mystery of Heaven continues to be revealed in our Second Reading from Revelation - the Heavenly Jerusalem is revealed and described. John speaks to the lack of a temple building stating that God Himself is the temple as well as the only light needed to illuminate the city. In our Gospel, the mystery continues for we hear Jesus promise the apostles that the Father will send the Holy Spirit to be with them. And with us.


