

#### Martha's Burdens

It's time to admit it: I've been unfair to Mary in the past. Been a little catty about her. *Oooh, Mary, she's so holy.* Well, do you like to eat, Mary? Who made your lunch? Yeah, that's right: it was Martha. Because you know what? It's the Marthas who get things done in the world while the Marys lounge around reading Aquinas and attending silent retreats and going to Eucharistic Adoration whenever they want.



And there you have it, folks: my bitterness on full display! I tend to identify with Martha, not with Mary, and I need to stop doing that.

Because I am not Martha instead of Mary. I am both. We are all both.

Mary was a woman; she was expected to do the serving, too. She shared that burden; she wasn't abandoning it, heaping her portion on Martha. And it's so wrong to assume that Mary didn't have the same cares and anxieties as Martha – perhaps she even had more!

Here's the difference: Mary, unlike Martha (and me, I guess) knew where to go with them.

We typically see our burdens as an impediment to a relationship with Christ. *I'm so busy. I'm so overwhelmed. There are so many demands on me, on my time, on my person, on my finances. Take a number, Jesus. Get in line.* But we're thinking the wrong way. Burdens aren't an obstacle that stands between us and Christ. Burdens are the straightest path to His feet.

God knows about burdens, okay? Aside from being all-wise and all-knowing, He basically completed a doctorate in suffering, taking on a human form (itself kind of a burden, if you think about it) and for 33 years lived among the hardest and heaviest burdens this world has to offer.

Why did He do this? Well, part of the reason was so that we could finally understand that our burdens aren't a barrier between us and God. On the contrary, they connect us to Him.

Are you anxious about many things? Then you need to be right where Mary is: at the feet of Jesus, with all your burdens.

This is a great option if your regular small group is taking a break for the summer. Pre-register if you can but walk-ins are welcome. More information at hnoi.org/smallgroups



## Faith Formation Registration, Early Bird Pricing Ends Soon

Faith Formation registration for 2025-2026 is now open and available with *early bird pricing until July 31*.

Sunday School is for ages three through Kindergarten and meets during the 8:30 and 10:30 a.m. Masses.

For 1st to 5th grades, we offer Faith Formation Wednesday night sessions from 4:45-6 p.m. or 6:15-7:30 p.m.



Students in the 2nd grade typically prepare for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion through the First Sacraments program.

Sessions for Middle School Crew (MS Crew) will take place on Wednesdays from 6:15-7:30 p.m.

All Faith Formation and youth ministry programs for high school teens (grades 9-12), including Confirmation preparation, retreats and Teen Core Team make up what we call "SH Crew" and meets on select Sunday evenings from 7-8:30 p.m.

## Scripture of the Week



"Looking up, Abraham saw three men standing nearby." (Genesis 18:2)

All three of our readings this week speak to the ministry of service. In our Second Reading, St. Paul speaks of his stewardship of bringing completion for the Word of God. Our First Reading speaks of the time the Lord appeared to Abraham - as three men - and both Abraham and Sarah serve Him/Them. Sarah



bakes each a roll and Abraham hurries to select a choice steer and have it prepared and then waits on the Lord while they eat.

In our Gospel from St. Luke, we hear the familiar tale of Mary and Martha. Martha, "burdened with much serving," asks Jesus to tell her sister Mary to help her. Mary, meanwhile, has been sitting at the feet of Jesus listening to His every word. Jesus's answer to Martha suggests that there is, perhaps, a sense of service in listening to His Word. Do we see listening to His Word as service? In fact, it may be the hardest service of all three examples this week. Because, if we listen and believe, we cannot be unchanged. His Word calls us to imitate Him and treat others accordingly.


