KC Auxiliary Bake Sale

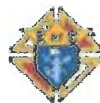
After all Masses Dec. 5 and 6

Scripture of the Week



"For you yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief at night."

(1 Thessalonians 5:2)

Last week we were reminded to stay awake for the arrival of the King even as our senses feel fall turning towards the sleep of winter under a blanket of snow. Our Gospel today shows us the result of falling asleep and not awakening until the King is already back. For all three servants in the story depict us after Jesus leaves the Earth and how we await His return.

The servant entrusted with a single talent reacts in fear of the master - fear of making a bad choice, fear of risking too much, really fear of everything - including a relationship with his master. And so he does nothing, exerts no effort in tending to what has been left in his care or in trying to strengthen his relationship to the master, as if he himself crawled into the hole and buried himself with the talent. The other two used the talents to make more to the joy and delight of the master. We are called to be HOLY not "hole-y".
