





# **FINANCIAL NOTES** & HIGHLIGHTS



- Total contributions (Sunday giving and other donations) came in ahead of budget, primarily due to a \$100K bequest and \$100K from a special gift.
- Total parish expenses were \$103K under budget. This was due in large part to not filling a pastoral care position. Maintenance expenses were \$20K over budget due to snow plowing last winter and removal of dead trees.
- School revenue was \$92K ahead of budget thanks to several new students along with increased donations, grants and fundraisers.
- School expenses were \$63K over budget but most of these expenses were covered by third party payments, fundraising and donations.

Although our Sunday giving has increased, we are still challenged with a large number of households that no longer give or have redirected their giving to other causes. We continue to be a thriving Parish that has deep roots in the community. Previous generations have been generous and with foresight and boldness, they established the Good Samaritan Fund, which to this day provides for needs within our community. We will be challenged with deferred maintenance and infrastructure needs in the near future and we continue to be fiscally responsible so that HNOJ will flourish for future generations. Our parish vision is to help each parishioner grow in discipleship and belonging. The prayer, participation and generosity of each parishioner will help us to achieve that vision together.
