praise him with your danc-ing, praise God till the end of days.



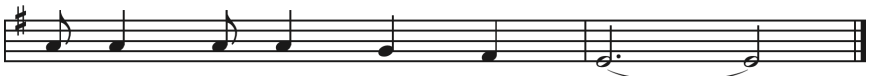
Come, then all you na-tions, sing of your Lord's good-ness,
